ORDINANCE NO. 825

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A DEED FROM JOHN L. RAY AND ESTELLA L. RAY CONVEYING TO THE CITY OF LEBANON THE WEST 20 FEET OF THE EAST 75 FEET OF LOTS 1 and 2 BLOCK 24, WM. RALSTON'S ADDITION TO THE CITY OF LEBANON AND DEDICATING THE SAME TO THE PUBLIC FOR THE USE OF AN ALLEY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The People of the City of Lebanon Do Ordain as Follows:

That a deed tendered to the City by John L. Ray and Estella L. Ray whereby they have conveyed to the City of Lebanon the following described property:

Beginning on the South line of Lot 2 Block 24 Wm. Ralston's Addition to Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, at a point which is 255 feet east of the S. W. corner of said Lot 2 and running thence north 254 feet, more or less to the north line of Lot 1 in said Block 24 Wm. Ralston's Addition; thence east 20 feet; thence south 254 feet; thence west 20 feet to the place of beginning, the same being the West 20 feet of even width of the East 75 feet of even width of Lots 1 and 2 Block 24 Wm. Ralston's Addition to the City of Lebanon.


be and the same is hereby accepted and that said real property be and the same is hereby dedicated to the public to be used as an alley.

This Ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
