BILL NC. 20 ORDINANCE NO. 849

THE FEOFLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: Section 1. That the mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver to Robert Langmack a bill of sale for the nursing home building located at the old hospital site on Second Street in the City of Lebanon upon receipt by him of \$350.00 being the purchase price for said building. The bill of sale shall contain a clause requiring the purchaser to remove said building on or before May 1, 1953.

Section 2. This ordinance being required for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
