ORDINANCE NO. 850 BILL NO. 1 FOR 1953

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 800, passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor on the 3rd day of January, 1951, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1 That there is hereby created and established in addition to the offices provided for by Section 33 of the Charter of the City of Lebanon as amemded on the 19th day of April, 1950, the offices of Recorder, Treasurer, City Attorney, Street Superintendent, and Marshal, the Marshal to be known as the Chief of Police, the offices of Assistant Recorder, Fire Chief, Health Officer and City Surveyor. It shall be lawful for the City Council to appoint one person only to perform the duties of the offices of City Recorder and Treasurer, and such appointment shall have the effect of filling both of said offices, and the officer so appointed shall be known as the Recorder-Treasurer of the City of Lebanon. Provided, however, that the City Council may by Resolution at any time, notwithstanding a prior appointment of one officer to perform the duties of the Recorder and Treasurer, appoint a City Treasurer, and the former Recorder-Treasurer shall thereafter perform anly the duties of and be known as the City Recorder.

Section 2 That the additional offices created by this ordinance are essential to the administration of city affairs, and the immediate establishment of these offices and appointments to fill the same is necessary for the peace, health, and safety of the City of Lebanon, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
