ORDINANCE BILL NO. 18 FOR 1903 ORDINANCE NO. 867 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 2 BY ADOPTING ANE NDMENTS TO THE THE FINE AND DECLARING AN EMA THE PROPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: No. 451 passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 20th day of March, 1934 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: Section 2. STATE LAW ADOPTED. The provisions of chapter 17, Second Special Session, Oregon Laws 1933, and also all acts up to the time of the passage of this ordinance amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, relating to the acquisition, possession, or disposition of alcoholic liquors, are hereby adopted as a portion of this ordinance so far as applicable, except as otherwise lawfully provided by this and other ordinances of the City of Lebanon. No. 451 shall be amended to read as follows: Section 11. PENALTIES. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in the city court, be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$200.00 or by imprisonment in the city jail for a period not exceeding fifty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. The police department shall keep a complete record of all complaints at the termination thereof brought under this ordinance. Section 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. Inasmuch as it is necessary to provide a means whereby the city court shall have jurisdiction over violations of the laws relating to the control of the alcoholic liquor control of said alcoholic traffic within this city, it is deemed necessary that an emergency be and the same is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become immediately operative from and after its passage by the council.
