A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING)

LATING TO THE LIQUOR CONTROL ACT) ORDINANCE NO. 888
AS LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL REGULA-)
TIONS FOR THE CITY OF LEBANON)

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS
FOLLOWS:

That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 451 passed by
the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 20th
day of March, 1934 as amended by Ordinance No. 867
passed by the council and approved by the Mayor on
the 18th day of August, 1953 be and the same is
hereby amended to read as follows:

Section I. Adopting Certain Sections of Ore-
gon Revised Statutes. The following enumerated
sections of the Oregon Revised Statutes, together
with all amendments which may be hereafter enacted
thereto, also all the regulations of the State of
Oregon Licuor Commission relating to the control,
manufacture, possession, sale, purchase, transpor-
tation, importation and delivery of alcoholic li-
quor issued pursuant to the authority granted there-
for by the hereinafter enumerated Section 471.730
O. R. S. including all regulations which may here-
after be issued and adopted by the commission, are
hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this
ordinance to the same extent as if the provisions
thereof were fully set forth herein:

- 471.005, 471.010, 471.015, 471.020, 471.025,
- 471.027, 471.030, 471.035, 471.125, 471.130,
- 471.135, 471.205, 471.250, 471.255, 471.260,
- 471.265, 471.345, Section 1 471.405, Sections 1,
- 2, 3, and 4, 471.410, 471.425, Section 2
- 471.430, 471.440, 471.445, 471.450, 471.452,
- 471.475, 471.610, 471.620, 471.657, 471.660,
- 471.675, 471.680, 471.730

All acts which are made unlawful and regulations
of the State Liquor Commission by the above mentioned
sections of the State laws shall be considered as of-
fences against the City of Lebanon when committed
within its boundaries and shall be punished by the pen-
alties hereinafter provided, which shall, for the pur-
poses of this ordinance, supersede all other penalties.

Section 2. Repealing conflicting ordinances
All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are duplicated by this ordinance or which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Emergency Clause. Inasmuch as it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety to provide a means whereby the city court shall have jurisdiction over violations of the laws relating to the control of the alcoholic liquor within this City, an emergency be and the same is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall become immediately operative from and after its passage by the council.
