ORDINANCE, NO. 894

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE SALARES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

The People of the City of Lebanon do Ordain as Follows:


Section 1: That the monthly salaries of the following city officers commencing January 1, 1955, and continuing until further ordinance of the Council, shall be in the amounts set after the office as follows:

City Recorder-Treasurer	\$375.00
Assistants City Recorder	275.00
Chief of Police	400.00
Other full time Police Officers	325.00
Police officer on desk	225.00
Paid Fireman	325.00
Street Superintendent	375.00
Other Street Employees	325.00
City Attorney	140.00
Assistant Chief of Police	341.67
Disposal Plant Operator	350.00

Section 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances which are in conflict hereunder be and the same are hereby repealed.


Section 3: Inasmuch as no official action has heretofore been taken setting the salaries of the officers hereinabove named, in accordance with the provisions in the City Charter and it being necessary that the City have in its employ the above named persons, and this ordinance being necessary for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Council and approval of the Mayor.
