ORDINANCE ~~B. 111~~ NO. 895

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

The People of the City of Lebanon do Ordain as Follows:


Section 1: That the monthly salaries of the following city officers for the period commencing February 1, 1955, and continuing until further ordinance of the Council shall be in the amounts set forth after the office as follows:

Care Taker, Housing Project	\$250.00
Combination Janitor & School Patrol	225.00
Municipal Judge, Department No. 1	275.00

Section 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances which are in conflict hereunder be and the same are hereby repealed.


Section 3: Inasmuch as no official action has heretofore been taken setting the salaries of the officers hereinabove named, in accordance with the provisions of the City Charter and it being necessary that the City have ~~be~~ in its employ the above named persons, and this ordinance being necessary for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Council and the approval of the Mayor.
