AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND A PORTION OF SECTION 8 of ORDINANCE NO. 585 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 678, TO PROVIDE FOR THE LICENSING OF POP-CORN AND PEANUT WAGONS ON STREETS.

Section 1: That Section 8 of Ordinance No. 585, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on February 5th, 1943, as amended by Ordinance No. 678, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 21st day of December, 1945, be amended to read and provide as follows:


8- "Section 8: Each applicant for license required by this ordinance shall pay a fee for the license according to the following fee schedule:

Section 2: That there is a pop-corn and peanut wagon operating on the streets of the City of Lebanon at this time, which desires to be licensed by the year and this ordinance is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
