A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE RE-ZONING A PORTION OF LEBANON LYING SOUTH OF THE MOUNTAIN STATES WATER CANAL AND BETWEEN MAIN STREETS AND SECOND STREETS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

The People of the City of Lebanon do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1: That the following described real property situated within the City limits of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, be and hereby is changed from "zone 2" (residential) to "zone 3" (business), to-wit:

Beginning at the N.W. corner of Morris Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, thence E. 95 feet to the true place of beginning; thence E. 75 feet; thence N. to the S. boundary line of that property that has heretofore been zoned as "zone 4" (industrial), thence W. 75 feet, more or less to a point that is due north of the true point of beginning; thence S. to the place of beginning, all being part of the William Ralston Addition to Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon.

Section 2: There is now a development anticipated in the above described property at this time, which in the opinion of the Council, would be advantageous to the City of Lebanon. Now therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be immediately operative and effective from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on this 15 day of March, 1955.
