THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Public Property Committee of the Common Council be and they are hereby directed to purchase the following described real property, to-wit:

Lot 6, Block 1, J. M. Ralston's Third Addition to City of Lebanon.

for the sum of \$12,500.00 and that the City Treasurer be and he hereby is directed to pay said purchase price when directed by the Public Property Committee. The Public Property Committee shall, before directing the payment of said \$12,500.00, request and receive a Warranty Deed conveying said property to the City of Lebanon free and clear of all encumbrances together with an owner's title insurance policy insuring the title to said premises in the City of Lebanon, subject to no exceptions whatsoever, except the usual printed exceptions.

It is hereby declared that in order to consumate the acquisition of the above described real property that action must be taken immediately and that this ordinance is necessary for the public peace, health and safety. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
