ORDINANCE BILL NO. 18
for 1955
ORDINANCE NO. 910

The People of the City of Lebanon do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate a taxicab service or business without first applying for and obtaining a license therefor from this City.

Section 2. That the license fee for such business, pursuit, or occupation shall be \$50.00 per calendar year or part thereof, which shall include the use of one vehicle, and \$20.00 per year or part thereof, for each additional vehicle used in said business; that said license shall not be transferable, and if revoked, no part thereof shall be refunded.

Section 3. That applications for licenses to operate such a business pursuit or occupation, and for an increase in the number of vehicles to be used therein, shall be made in writing to the City Council of said City, and each application shall contain a statement, under oath, of the applicant as to his or its financial status and responsibility, the description of the equipment to be used and the type of service the applicant shall render. The Council shall have the right to demand further information and particulars concerning the applicant and the service he proposes to render, and shall be the sole and final judge of whether the applicant is properly qualified to enter such business and render such service within the City of Lebanon, and thereafter to continue in the same, if there arises a question as to whether said license should be revoked for good cause, or should be renewed, and as to whether there is a public necessity and convenience to justify the granting of said application and the issuance of said license, and there shall be no appeal from the rejection of any such application or revocation of any such license by a majority vote of the Council.


Section 4. This Ordinance expressly repeals Ordinance No. 647 and 656.

Section 5. This Ordinance being necessary to provide for the control of the operation of taxicabs businesses in the city of Lebanon, this ordinance is necessary for the peace, health, and safety of the citizens thereof, and an emergency is therefore hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
