ORDINANCE NO. 922

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SHALL THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED TERRITORY BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF LEBANON ?

Beginning at a point which is West 146.20 feet from the West line of Twelfth Street if extended North, said beginning point being N. 89 deg. 39' E. 1565.82 feet and N. O deg. 17' W. 159.00 feet from the Northwest corner of the Jeremiah Ralston D.L.C. No. 49 in T. 12 S. R. 2 W. of the Willamette Meridian In Linn County, Oregon; and running thence Southerly parallel to the West line of Twelfth Street to the North line of Sherman Street produced
West, thence Southerly parallel to Twelfth Street (of Green Acres)
Addition) to the South line of D.L.C. No. 49, thence Southerly
parallel to the West line of D.L.C. No. 48 to a point South 198.0
feet from the South line of D.L.C. No. 68, thence Easterly parallel
to the South line of D.L.C. No. 68 to the Southwest corner of Lot l in Arnold Subdivision, thence Easterly along the South line of Lots 1,2,3,4,5 and 6 in Arnold Subdivision and said lots line produced Easterly to the East line of Seventh Street, thence Southerly along the East line of Seventh Street to the North line of Kees Streets, thence East along the North line of Kees Street to a point on the West line (produced North) of Lot 1, Block 2, Harmony Subdivision, thence Southerly along said line and the West line of Lots 1 and 4, Block 2, continuing Southerly across Wassom Street and along the West line of Lot 1, Block 5 to the South line of Harmony Subdivision, thence East along the South line of said Subdivision to the West line of Sixth Street, thence North along the West line of Sixth Street to the North line of Walker Road (if produced West), thence Easterly along the North line of Walker Road to the West line of the road formerly known as the Big Brother's Farm Road, thence Northerly along the West line of said Big Brother's Farm Road to the Southwesterly line of the Southerly and Southeasterly route from Second Street, thence Southeasterly along the said line of Second Street Route to the Westerly line of the South Santiam Highway, thence Southeasterly along said highway line to a point South 150.0 feet from the South line (if produced West) of Gilbert Street in Morgan Subdivision, thence Easterly parallel to the South line of Gilbert Street to the Westerly right of way line

of the Oregon Electric Railway, thence Northerly along said railway line to the present South boundary of the City of Lebanon, thence Westerly along the present South boundary of Lebanon to the present Southwest corner of Lebanon, thence North along the present West boundary of Lebanon to a point North 129.0 feet from the North line of Tangent Street, thence Westerly parallel to the North line of the Jeremiah Ralston D.L.C. No. 49 to the place of beginning.

Section II That the title for the ballot to be used in each of of saidelections shall be as follows:

ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY PROPOSED BY ORDINANCE OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON AND REFERRED TO THE LEGAL ELECTORS.

Section III That the proposition to be printed on the ballot shall be as follows:

SHALL THE ABOVE DESCRIBED TERRITORY BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON?

Section IV That the City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to publish and post notices of said election in the manner provided by law.

Section VII That the polling places for said elections shall be open from the hour of 8 A.M. to 8 P.M. of said day; that the Chief of Police is instructed to place polling booths, pens, pencisl, and ballots for the purpose of providing for said election and the Recorder is directed to provide poll books therefore;

Section VIII WHEREAS, if the City of Lebanon is going to provide services for the proposed territory to be annexed within the near future, it is necessary that the election called for in this Ordinance be held at the earliest possible date, and existing conditions are necessary that said election be held forthwith, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist it being necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
