A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF BEBANON CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY ORDINANCE BILL NO. ______ for 1956 ORDINANCE NO. ______

WHEREAS, written consent of all the owners of certain real property have signed their consent that said real property be annexed to the City of Lebanon, therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That whereas the owners of all the following described real property, to-wit:

Starting at the intersection of the West bank of the Lebanon Canal and the South line of the present city limits of the City of Lebanon, Oregon; thence Southerly along the West bank of the Lebanon Canal to a point that is 130 feet South of the present City limits; thence West parallel to the South line of said City limits to a point 160 feet East of the East line of 5th Street, if extended; thence South parallel to 5th Street, if extended, to the North line of the Airport road; thence West along the North line of the Airport Road to the East line of 7th Street; thence North along the East line of 7th Street to the South Boundary of the City limits of Lebanon, thence East to the place of beginning.

have filed with the Recorder of the City of Lebanon a written consent that such real property be annexed to the City of Lebanon;

That said property is contiguous territory to the City of Lebanon; and That an ordinance has heretofore been passed declaring that an election within the City of Lebanon shall not be held.

Section 2. Said territory is hereby declared to be annexed to the City of Lebanon, and the City Recorder is hereby directed to make and submit to the Secretary of the State of Oreg on a copy of this ordinance, together with a copy of the written consent of the owners of all of the above described territory herein annexed to the City of Lebanon, and also a copy of the ordinance declaring that no election shall be required within the said City of Lebanon.
