A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TAKING JURISDICTION OF THE PROPOSED DRAINAGE DISTRICT ABOVE DESCRIBED, KNOWN AS DRAINAGE DISTRICT NUMBER #8 and ORDERING RECORDER TO PUBLISH NOTICE INVITING PROPOSALS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF DRAINS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY:

ORDINANCE BILL NO. <u>19</u> for 1956 ORDINANCE NO. 944

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 13 for 1956, passed by the Council and approved by the M Mayor on the 3rd day of April, 1956, the Council declared the property described below to be a drainage district, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has made and filed plans, specifications and estimates for the drainage of said area which were approved and adopted by said Resolution, and

WHEREAS, the City Recorder has caused notice of intention of the City to make said improvements, and the time for publication thereof, as prescribed by the Charter has elapsed and no remonstrance thereto has been made or filed herein, now therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

I.

That the Council does hereby take jurisdiction of the proposed drainage

district described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 5, Kirkpatrick's Addition to the City of Lebanon, Oregon; and running thence North along the East line of the alley through Block 4, Kirkpatrick's Second Addition and to the South line of Block 3, Kirkpatrick's Second Addition, thence East to the Southeast corner of said Block 3, thence North along the East line of said Block 3 to the South line of Wheeler Street, thence East along said street line 246.86 feet, thence N. 1 deg. 54' W. 210.11 feet to a point 150.00 feet North of the North line of Wheeler Street, thence East parallel to said street line to the Easterly Boundary of the City of Lebanon, thence Southeasterly along the Easterly City boundary to the Northeast corner of Block 4, Kirkpatrick's Third Addition, thence Westerly along the North line of Block 4, said addition, the North line of Lots 4, 7 and 11 in Block 3, said addition, the North line of Lots 5, Kirkpatrick's Addition, and the North line of Lots 1, Block 5, Kirkpatrick's Addition to the place of beginning,

and orders that the improvement shall be done by contract to be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder with the right of the City to reject any and all bids.

II.

That the Recorder is hereby ordered to publish for ten (10) days in a

newspaper published in Lebanon, Oregon, a notice inviting proposals for the construction of said drains referring to the plans and specifications and estimates therefore filed in his office.

III.

That said work shall commence not later than seven (7) days after the contract has been awarded, and shall be completed prior to $\frac{PGG.15,1956}{PGG.15,1956}$

IV.

That said work shall be done in the manner provided by the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Council; and the Contractor shall be subject to the penalties for default or failure to complete said work in the manner and within the time provided in his contract with the City, and shall indemnify the City by a bond in an appropriate amount with a surety or sureties approved by the Council for the faithful and prompt performance of said contract, and for the payment of damages for the failure thereof in the sum or sums provided in said contract.

v.

It hereby is adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon; and an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
