

newspaper published in Lebanon, Oregon, a notice inviting proposals for the construction of said drains referring to the plans and specifications and estimates therefore filed in his office.

III.

That said work shall commence not later than seven (7) days after the contract has been awarded, and shall be completed prior to AUG. 15, 1956.

IV.

That said work shall be done in the manner provided by the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Council; and the Contractor shall be subject to the penalties for default or failure to complete said work in the manner and within the time provided in his contract with the City, and shall indemnify the City by a bond in an appropriate amount with a surety or sureties approved by the Council for the faithful and prompt performance of said contract, and for the payment of damages for the failure thereof in the sum or sums provided in said contract.

V.

It hereby is adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon; and an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
