ORDINANCE NO. 952

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) That the Mayor and the Recorder be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract with the engineering firm of CORNELL, HOWLAND, HAYES & MERRYFIELD, for obtaining plans, specifications and supervision of the construction of the necessary additions to the existing sewage treatment plant as called for by the State Board of Health. A copy of said contract is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof.

Section (2) Whereas, the State of Oregon has heretofore required that such additional facilities be installed and whereas, it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Lebanon that such additional facilities be added at the earliest possible date. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
