THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That Section (1) of Ordinance No. 937 as passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 3rd day of April, 1956, be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section (1) It shall be unlawful for any pedestrian to cross any public street within the City of Lebanon at any place other than the marked crosswalks at the various intersections within the City of Lebanon, unless there shall be no marked crosswalk within 200 feet from the point of crossing said public street.
