AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR ADVERTISEMENT OF SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT BONDS AND SETTING A NEW DATE FOR SALE. ORDINANCE BILL NO. 39 for 1956 ORDINANCE NO. 964

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Common Council that the bids heretofore received and the acceptance of said bid for the sale of the city's sewage disposal plant bonds are invalid because the advertisement for the sale of said bonds was not run a sufficient length of time prior to the date of the sale, now therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) That the Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby directed to advertise the bonds provided in Ordinance No. 959 as passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 21st day of August, 1956, and that said sale shall be held on the 20th day of November, 1956, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m. in the Council Chambers of the City Hall, City of Lebanon.

Section (2) That inasmuch as the proceeds from the sale of the aforementioned bonds is needed immediately for the purposes therein stated, the sale must be made as soon as possible, therefore, for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
