THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That the Mayor of the City of Lebanon, and each of the members of the Common Council, be and hereby are allowed the sum of \$25.00 per calendar month to reimburse said Mayor and Councilmen for the expenses incurred by them in the performance of their official duties.

Section II, That inasmuch as the new council is being formed on this date, and the Mayor and Councilmen have already entered into their official duties and should be reimbursed for their expenses commencing January 1, 1957, and it being necessary to preserve the public peace, health and safety of the citizens of Lebanon, that said Mayor and Council do perform the various services from time to time and incur said expenses, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
