ORDINANCE NO. 988

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) That the Mayor and the Recorder be, and hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Lebanon Sand & Gravel Company for the construction of sidewalks from Rose Street North along the East side of Sixth Street and the West side of Fifth Street, and to obligate the City for the payment of \$1797.97 upon completion of the work. Said contract to contain the specifications and proposals that have heretofore been approved by the Common Council.

Section (2) That inasmuch as said construction of sidewalks is necessary to be commenced immediately if the orderly development of said park is to proceed, therefore, it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Lebanon that said work be done immediately, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on this 7th day of May, 1957.
