ORDINANCE NO. 989

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) That the Mayor and the Recorder be and hereby are authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Ron Cox for the installation of plumbing in the City Park situated North of Rose Street between Fifth and Sixth Street and to obligate the City for the payment of \$2180.00 upon completion of the work. Said contract to contain the specifications and proposals that have heretofore been approved by the Common Council.

Section (2) That inasmuch as said plumbing installation is necessary to be commenced immediately if the orderly development of said park is to proceed, therefore, it being necessary for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Lebanon that said work be done immediately, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
