

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TAKING JURISDICTION ) ORDINANCE BILL NO. 30

 AND ORDERING SAME TO BE DONE BY CONTRACT TO THE ) for 1957  
 LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER, AND DIRECTING THE )  
 CITY RECORDER TO PUBLISH NOTICE INVITING ) ORDINANCE NO. 997  
 PROPOSALS FOR BIDS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. )

WHEREAS, there has been filed a petition signed by the owners of all of the real property abutting upon and to be benefitted by the construction of the following described sidewalk, to-wit:

The sidewalk on the West side of Williams Street, commencing at the Southeast corner of Lot 6, G. W. Wheeler's Addition to the City of Lebanon, and running thence North 125 feet, more or less, to the existing sidewalk. and

WHEREAS the Council has thereafter approved plans, specifications, estimates and costs of making said improvements, now therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

I.

That the Common Council does hereby take jurisdiction of the proposed sidewalk improvement which is as follows:

The sidewalk on the West side of Williams Street, commencing at the Southeast corner of Lot 6, G.W. Wheeler's Addition to the City of Lebanon, and running thence North 125 feet, more or less, to the existing sidewalk.,

and orders that the sidewalk improvement in said district shall be done by contract to be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder with the right of the City to refuse any and all bids.

II.

That the Recorder is hereby ordered to publish for 10 days in a newspaper published in Lebanon, Oregon, a notice inviting proposals for making the sidewalk improvements in the above named sidewalk improvement district, said notice to refer to the plans and specifications heretofore filed in the office of the Recorder and the time when said work shall be completed.

Work in said district shall commence not later than JUNE 15,  
1957 and shall be completed not later than JULY 15, 1957.

III.

That said work in said district shall be done in the manner provided by the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Council, and that the contractor shall be subject to the penalties for default or failure to complete said work, and in the manner and within the time provided by his contract with the City, and shall indemnify the City by a bond in an appropriate amount, with a surety or sureties approved by the Council for the faithful and prompt performance of said contract and for the payment of damages for the failure thereof in the sum or sums provided in said contract.

IV.

That the existing conditions are such that the sidewalk above mentioned is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
