A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TAKING JURISDICTION OF THE FOLLOWING PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT: THE GRAVELLING OF EDDIE STREET FROM ELMORE STREET TO THE SOUTH END OF EDDIE STREET, AND PROVIDING THAT THE CITY MAKE SAID IMPROVEMENTS AND DE-CLARING AN EMERGENCY.

ORDINANCE BILL NO.<u>3/</u> for 1957 ORDINANCE NO. 998

WHEREAS, there has been filed herein a petition signed by the owners of more than 50 per cent of the real property abutting upon and to be benefitted by the above described street improvement, which petition has been approved by the Council, and

WHEREAS, the Council thereafter approved the plans, specifications and estimates of the cost of making said improvement, and caused notice of intention to make said improvement to be published in the manner provided by the Charter, and

WHEREAS, the time for remonstrances to be made to said street improvement has elapsed and no remonstrances have been made or filed herein, now therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

I.

That the Council does hereby take jurisdiction of the proposed street improvement, to-wit: the gravelling of Eddie Street from Elmore Street to the South end of Eddie Street, in said street improvement district, and orders that the street improvement in said district shall be done by the street department of the city of Lebanon.

II.

That existing conditions are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and an emergency is hereby declared and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
