THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Recorder be and hereby are authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the sum of \$160.50, which is substantially in words and figures as follows, to-wit:

CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS.

This contract made and entered into this 10th day of June, 1957, between the City of Lebanon, Oregon, a municipal corporation, by its City Council, hereinafter called "CITY", and ROBERT G. WRIGHT of Lebanon, Oregon, hereinafter called, "CONTRACTOR".

WITNESSETH:

Said Contractor, in consideration of the sum to be paid him by the said City and of the covenants and agreements herein contained, hereby agrees at his own proper cost and expense, to do all the work and furnish all the materials as listed in the general conditions, tools, labor and all appliances and appurtenances for the construction of the improvement of sidewalks, to the extent of the proposal made by the Contractor on the 4th day of June, 1957, and in full compliance with the contract documents referred to herein. The "Advertisement for Bids," the "Information for Bidders", the signed copy of the "Proposal", made by the Contractor on the 4th day of June, 1957, the "General Condition", the "Specifications", and the "Plans", which consist of detail sheets numbered and titled as follows:

1. Section details of combined curb and walk
2. Section details of curb and walk with parking strip between

In consideration of the faithful performance of the work herein embraced, as set forth in these contract documents and in accordance with the direction of the Engineer and to his satisfaction to the extent provided in the contract documents, the City agrees to pay to the Contractor, the amount of the bid as submitted in said proposal made by the Contractor, and to make such payments within 15 DAYS days after the completion of all things hereinbefore proposed to be done by the Contractor.

The Contractor agrees to complete the work within the time specified herein and to accept as full payment the amount set forth in his proposal.

It is agreed that the time limit for the completion of the contract, based upon the proposal, shall be the 30th day of June, 1957.
