

ORDINANCE NO. 1002

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a Contract with the Lebanon Sand and Gravel Company, a co-partnership, for street improvements and to obligate the City for the payment of \$48,325.29 for said street improvements, and that the contract shall refer to the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Common Council and shall be in the following form, to-wit:

Section (2) That inasmuch as this Contract is for the improvement of streets, it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the City of Lebanon that said work be done immediately, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ^{ORDINANCE} ~~contract~~ shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
