ORDINANCE NO. 1006

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Thomas E. Gates & Sons for the construction of a park shelter building and to obligate the City for the payment of the sum of \$11,990. Said building to be constructed according to he plans and specifications of Wick & Brown, Architects, designated as job number 5744 and said contract to call for the commencement of said building within 30 days and the complettion of same, on or before November 30, 1957.

Section 2. That in as much, as the weather in the State of Oregon, makes building uneconomical during the winter months, this contract must be signed immediately, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, it is necessary for the peace, health, and safety of the citizens of the City of Lebanon and this ordinance should be in full force and effect, its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.

Said contractor in consideration of the sum of \$11,990, to be paid to him by the said "City" and of the covenants and agreements herein contained, hereby agrees, at his own proper cost and expense to do all the work and furnish all the materials, tools, labor and appliances, for the construction of the park shelter building on the City Park, near the intersection of 5th & Rose, the exact location to be designated by the City Engineer and to construct said building in full compliance with the specifications and plans as prepared by Wicks & Brown, Architects, designated as Job 5744, which said specifications and plans are incorporated herein, and by this reference made a part hereof,

In consideration of the faithful performance of the work herein embraced, as set forth in the contract documents, the City agrees to pay the Contractor the aforementioned sum of money as provided in the specifications.

It is further agreed by the Contractor, that he shall commence work within 30 days after signing of this contract and shall complete said park shelter building on or before the 30th of November 1957.
