THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) That the Mayor and the Recorder are hereby authorized
and directed to enter into the following contract:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the City of Lebanon, a municipal corporation hereinafter referred to as CITY and _____

PAUL V. BAKER

hereinafter referred to as CONTRACTOR, in consideration of the mutual covenants, promises and agreements hereinafter contained, agree as follows:

Contractor agrees to furnish a following:

All of the above mentioned trees to be of branched stock and shall be staked at the time of planting with a minimum of two stakes of adequate size and all trees shall be planted not later than the 31st day of March, 1958, and of good quality and healthy stock. Contractor further guarantees that said trees shall be free from disease at time of planting and the Contractor further agrees that he shall plant all of said trees at his own proper cost and expense in locations furnished to him by the surveyor of the aforementioned City, in accordance with the plans and specifications which shall be furnished to the contractor by the City.

In consideration of the Contractors faithfully performing the above mentioned covenants and agreements, the City shall pay to Contractor the sum of \$ 400⁰⁰ Dollars with THIRTY DAYS from the

time the Contractor completes the aforementioned furnishing of trees and other material and work to be done by the Contractor.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the City has caused this Contract to be executed by and through its Mayor and Recorder and the Contractor has signed on behalf of himself on this 31st day of OCTOBER, 1957.


