WHEREAS, upon the expiration of the time required by the Charter for the submission of bids, the bids received by the City Recorder for the making of said street improvement were opened and submitted to the Council and, Joe D. Morse, Forrest E. Morse and William F. Morse dba Lebanon Sand & Gravel, a responsible bidder having submitted the lowest bid, was awarded the contract for making said street improvement, and

WHEREAS, the work and improvement has been completed and approved, having been done in accordance with the Charter and Ordinance of the said City of Lebanon, and the costs of said work and improvements has been determined, now therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That the costs of improving said street to be borne by the property abutting upon and adjacent to the above described proposed street is \$ 2,070.76 .

Section II. That the proportionate share of said cost of said work and improvement to be borne by the real property especially benefitted thereby and to be assessed therefor is hereby declared to be the amount set immediately after the separate description of each lot or tract of land hereinafter stated, and each of said lots or tracts of land is determined and declared to be benefitted by said improvement in the sum equal to or greater than the amount assessed thereto hereinafter; and each of said lots or tracts of land should be, and the same hereby is, assessed for its proportionate share of the cost of said improvement in the sum set opposite the description thereof, to-wit:

Section III. Section IV. That the said City of Lebanon having seriously depleted its funds and this ordinance therefore being required for the peace, health and safety of said City, an emergency is hereby declared and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
