

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION ON MAY 23, 1958, SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL ELECTORS A PROPOSITION FOR THE AUTHORIZATION OF A LEVY BY THE CITY OF LEBANON OF A TAX IN THE SUM OF \$57,492.00 OUTSIDE THE CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AND USING FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT, POLICE DEPARTMENT, FIRE DEPARTMENT, ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT, PARK DEPARTMENT, PUBLIC PROPERTY DEPARTMENT, GENERAL GOVERNMENT AND MISCELLANEOUS EXPENDITURES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) That a special election be held in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, on the 23rd day of May, 1958, between the hours of 8:00 O'Clock A.M., and 8:00 P.M., for the purpose of submitting a proposed tax levy in excess of the 6% constitutional limitation which is now on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Lebanon which has been proposed by the Common Council by Resolution heretofore unanimously passed.

Section (2) That the following proposition be submitted to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon at said special election.

That the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, by and through its Common Council, be and hereby is, authorized and empowered to levy a tax in the sum of \$57,492.00 against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of said city outside the limitations empowered by Article 11, Section 11 of the Constitution of the State of Oregon for the fiscal year 1958-59 for the purpose of providing funds for the operation and maintenance of the sewage disposal plant, police department, fire department, park department, public property department, general government and miscellaneous expenditures of the City of Lebanon and for all or any one or combination of such purposes and to use such funds derived from such levy for such purposes and no other.

Section (3) That the ballot title for the proposed proposition shall be as follows:

Shall the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon by and through its Common Council, be authorized to levy for the purpose of providing and using funds for the operation and maintenance of the sewage disposal plant, police department, engineering department, park department, public property department, general government and miscellaneous expenditures of the said City, a tax in the sum of \$57,492.00 against all the taxable property within the limits of said city outside the constitutional 6% limitation of the State of Oregon for the fiscal year 1958-59.

Section (4) That the proposition to be printed on the ballot shall be as follows:

A proposition submitted to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon by the Council at a special election to be held on the 23d day of May, 1958, for a tax in the sum of \$57,492.00 outside the constitutional limitation.

Section (5) That said proposal for the authorization of a special levy shall be placed upon the official ballot by the City Recorder to be voted upon by the legal electors of the City of Lebanon at said election.

Section (6) That the Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby authorized and directed to publish said notices of said election in the manner provided by law.

Section (7) That the following places for said election in the City of Lebanon shall be as follows:

Ward One - Precincts 1 and 2.

Section (8) That the Clerks and Judges of said election shall be as follows:

Section (9) That the polling places for said election shall be open from the hour of 8:00 o'clock A.M. to 8:00 o'clock P.M., on said day and the Chief of Police is instructed to place polling booths, pens, pencils and ballots for the purpose of

providing for said election and the Recorder is directed to provide poll books, therefor.

Section (10) Inasmuch as there is an immediate necessity for the adoption of the 1958-59 budget, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Lebanon, and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
