WHEREAS, there has been filed a petition signed by the owners of the real property to be especially benefited by the above described sidewalk improvements, which petition has been approved by the Council, and

WHEREAS, the work and improvement has been completed and approved, having been done in accordance with the Charter and Ordinance of the City of Lebanon, and the costs of said work and improvements have been determined, now therefore,

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That the costs of improving said sidewalk to be borne by the property abutting upon and adjacent to the above described sidewalk is \$ 261.00.

Section II. That the proportionate share of said cost of said work and improvement to be borne by the real property especially benefited thereby, and to be assessed therefor is hereby declared to be the amount set immediately after the separate description of each lot or tract of land hereinafter stated, and each of said lots or tracts of land is determined and declared to be benefited by said improvement in the sum equal to or greater than the amount assessed thereto hereinafter; and each of said lots or tracts of land should be, and the same hereby is, assessed for its proportionate share of the cost of said improvement in the sum set opposite the description thereof, to-wit:

Lot 10, Block 8, J. M. Ralston's Fourth Addition. 174 feet @ \$1.50. \$261.00.

Section III. That the Recorder of the City of Lebanon be, and he is, hereby ordered and directed to immediately enter a statement of each assessment made, declared and levied by this Ordinance, together with the names of the respective owners of such lots and tract of land hereinabove described, in the Docket of City Liens of said City, as provided by the Charter; and to give notice forthwith to the owners of all of said property as to said assessments, as provided by the Charter of said City of Lebanon.

Section IV. That the said City of Lebanon having seriously depleted its funds and this Ordinance therefore being required for the peace, health and safety

of said City, an emergency is hereby declared and said Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
