ORDINANCE NO.

THE FEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: SECTION I. ADOPTING CERTAIN SECTIONS OF OREGON REVISED STATUTES. The following enumerated sections of the Oregon Revised Statutes, together with all amendments which may hereinafter be enacted thereto, are hereby adopted by reference end made a part of this ordinance to the same extent as if the provisions thereof were fully set forth herein:

All acts which are made unlawful by the above mentioned sections of the state laws shall be considered as offenses against the City of Lebanon when committed within its boundaries and shall be punished by the penalties hereinafter provided, which shall, for the purposes of this ordinance, supersede all other penalties.

SECTION II. That Ordinance Number 289 be and is hereby repealed.

That the use and explosion of fireworks within the City of Lebanon makes this ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and an emergency is hereby declared and said ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
