The People of the City of Lebanon do Ordain as Follows:


Section 1: That the maximum salaries of the following city officers commencing July 1, 1958, and continuing until further ordinance of the Council, shall be in the amounts set after the office as follows:

City Recorder-Treasurer	\$485.00	per month
Assistant City Recorder	350.00	" "
Chief of Police	485.00	" "
Assistant Chief of Police	412.50	" "
Regular Police Officers	375.00	" "
Radio-Phone Operators (Matrons)	245.00	" "
Fire Chief	485.00	" "
Assistant Fire Chief	412.50	" "
Regular Firemen	375.00	" "
Street Superintendent	485.00	" "
Other Street Employees	375.00	" "
Sewer Treatment Plant Operator	375.00	" "
Judge, Municipal Court, Dist. #1	75.00	" "
Judge, Municipal Court, Dist. #2	10.00	per hour
City Attorney	420.00	quarterly

Section 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances which are in conflict hereunder be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3: That the 1958-59 budget which has been adopted calls for the above sums of money to be paid to the respective officers and employees during the fiscal year July 1, 1958, through June 30, 1959, and that the various officers and employees above named have relied upon said salaries. Therefore, this Ordinance is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon and an emergency is hereby declared to exist. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after it is passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
