THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) That the Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to enter into the following contract:

8 foot fence (around multi-purpose courts)
10 foot fence (around 3 tennis courts)

No. 11 gauge wire 1 3/4 inch mesh, knuckled salvage top and bottom, 1 5/8 inch 0. D. pipe, weight 2.27# lin. ft., for top rail and bracing, end, corner and gate posts 3" 0. D. pipe, 5.79# lin. ft., line posts to be H or I beam, weight 2.72# lin. ft., set in concrete bases to depth of 36 inches.

3 standard swing walk gates 3 ft. by 7 ft., 1 5/8 inch 0. D. frame, complete with ball and socket hinges, no welded corners accepted.

Post spacing 10 feet apart.

CONTRACT

THIS CONTRACT made and entered into this _____day of ______.
1958, by and between the CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, by its City Council hereinafter called the "City", and CYCLONE FENCE, AMERICAN STEEL AND WIRE DIVISION, UNITED STATES STEEL CORPORATION, hereinafter called the "Contractor".

WITNESSETH:

- 1. Said Contractor, in consideration of the sum to be paid him by the said City and of the covenants and agreements herein contained, hereby agrees as follows:
 - (a) To furnish all the materials listed in the specifications attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A". Do all the work necessary to install said materials in the City Park.
 - (b) All the work of installation to be done under the supervision of the City Engineer.
- 2. In consideration of the faithful performance of the work herein embraced, in accordance with the direction of the Engineer and to his satisfaction, the City agrees to pay to the Contractor the sum of \$3,799.00.
- 3. It is agreed that the time limit for completion of the Contract shall be the 30th day of November, 1958. In the event the Contractor shall fail to complete the work within the time limit, or the extended time limit agreed upon, liquidated damages shall be computed at the rate of FIFTEEN DOLLARS (\$15.00) per day.
