

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND THE RECORDER OF THE CITY OF LEBANON TO ACCEPT A DEED FROM L. E. ARNOLD AND CLARA P. ARNOLD OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY LOCATED IN THE CITY OF LEBANON AND DEDICATED TO THE CITY OF LEBANON FOR STREET PURPOSES.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) That the Mayor and the Recorder of the City of Lebanon be directed to accept a Deed from L. E. Arnold and Clara P. Arnold of the following described real property located in the City of Lebanon and donated to the City of Lebanon, Oregon, for street purposes, to-wit:

Beginning at a 3/4" Iron pipe on the Easterly line of South Second Street, said Iron pipe being S. 7° 30.5' W. 262.04 feet from the Southwest corner of Santa Barbara-Zeitler Addition to the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon; and running thence N. 7° 30.5' E. along the Easterly line of Second Street 44.35 feet to a 1" Iron pipe, thence S. 89° 38' E. parallel to the South line of the William Ralston D.L.C. No. 48, a distance of 305.91 feet to a 1" Iron pipe, thence S. 0° 09' W. 44.00 feet to a 1" Iron pipe, thence N. 89° 38' W. 311.63 feet to the place of beginning, this conveyance being for street purposes.

Section (2) Whereas, the aforementioned described real property is now being used for street purposes, it is now being used for street purposes, it is necessary for the public health, safety and welfare that this Ordinance Bill become effective immediately and an emergency is hereby declared.
