ORDINANCE NO. 1065

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) That Section 3, of Ordinance No. 519 be and hereby is amended to have added the following:

3a. Any person who is not enrolled as a student or who is not employed by the public or private school and who, without a lawful purpose therefor, wilfully loiters about any public or private school building or the public premises adjacent thereto, or any person who conducts himself in a violent, riotous or disorderly manner, or uses any abusive or obscene language in any street or highway, house or place whereby the peace or quiet of the neighborhood or vicinity may be disturbed shall be guilty of vagrancy.

Section (2) It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passing by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
