ORDINANCE BILL NO. 3  
for 1960.  
ORDINANCE NO. 1072

WHEREAS, the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon has established a curfew which is in conflict with the present existing curfew established by Ordinance in the City of Lebanon; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the curfew enforced in the City of Lebanon be in conformity with the curfew established throughout the State of Oregon; and

NOW THEREFORE, PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. That Ordinance No. 566 establishing a curfew be and is hereby repealed.

Section II. That the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.
