A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION ON AUGUST 8, 1960, SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL ELECTORS A PROPOSITION FOR THE AUTHORIZATION OF A LEVY BY THE CITY OF LEBANON OF A TAX IN THE SUM OF \$47,474.47 OUTSIDE THE CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITATIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING AND USING FUNDS FOR THE OPERATION OF STREET LIGHTS AND WATER, THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A CITY LIBRARY, THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CITY PARKS, AND FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SEWAGE DISPOSAL PLANT, FOR EACH OF THE FIVE TAX YEARS BEGINNING WITH FISCAL TAX YEAR 1960-61, TO AND INCLUDING THE FISCAL TAX YEAR 1964-65, AND DELCARING AN EMERGENCY

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) That a special election be held in the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, on the 8th day of August, 1960, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A.M., and 8:00 o'clock P.M., for the purpose of submitting a proposed tax levy in excess of the 6% constitutional limitation which is now on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Lebanon which has been proposed by the Common Council by Resolution heretofore unanimously passed.

Section (2) That the following proposition be submitted to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon at said special election.

> That the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, by and through its Common Council be, and is hereby, authorized and empowered to levy a tax in the sum of \$47,474.47 (which would equal a ten mill levy based upon the 1959-60 assessed valuation, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of said City, outside the limitations imposed by Article XI, Section 11 of the Constitution of the State of Oregon, for each of the five tax years beginning with the fiscal year 1960-61, to and including the fiscal tax year 1964-65, for the purpose of providing funds for the operation of street lights and water, the operation and maintenance of the city library, the operation and maintenance of city parks, and for the operation of the sewage disposal plant, and for all, or any one or combination of such purposes, and to use such funds derived from such tax for such purposes and no other.

Section (3) That the ballot title for the proposed proposition shall be as follows:

Shall the City of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, by and through its Common Council, be authorized to

levy for the purpose of providing funds for the operation of street lights and water, operation and maintenance of a city library, operation and maintenance of city parks, operation and maintenance of the sewage disposal plant, a tax in the sum of \$\\\\\$47,474.47, against all the taxable property within the corporate limits of said city, outside the constitutional 6% limitation of the State of Oregon for each of the five fiscal tax years, 1960-61, to and including 1964-65.

Section (4) That the proposition to be printed on the ballot shall be as follows:

A proposition submitted to the legal electors of the City of Lebanon by its Common Council at a special election to be held on the 8th day of August, 1960, for a tax in the sum of \$\frac{1}{2},47\frac{1}{4}.47\$ outside the constitutional 6% limitation for each of the five fiscal tax years, 1960-61 through 1964-65 inclusive.

Section (5) That said proposal for the authorization of a special levy shall be placed upon the official ballot by the City Recorder to be voted upon by the legal electors of the City of Lebanon at said election.

Section (6) That the Recorder of the City of Lebanon is hereby authorized and directed to publish said notices of said election in the manner provided by law.

Section (7) That the polling places for said election in the City of Lebanon shall be as follows:

Ward One - Precincts 1, 2 and 10.

Hoeck Chevrole t Company 1010 Main Street Lebanon, Oregon

Ward Two - Precincts 3, 4 and 9.

Lebanon Junior High School Lebanon, Oregon

Ward Three - Precincts 5, 6, 7 and 8.

City Hall 925 Main Street Lebanon, Oregon

Section (8) That the Clerks and Judges of said election shall be as follows:

Section (9) That the polling places for said election shall be open from the hour of 8:00 o'clock A.M. to 8:00 o'clock P.M., on said day and the Chief of Police is instructed to place polling booths, pens, pencils and ballots for the purpose of providing for said election and the Recorder is directed to provide poll books, therefore.

Section (10) Inasmuch as the City of Lebanon is without funds to maintain services comparable with the 1959-60 services an emergency is hereby delcared to exist and this Ordinance is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of the City of Lebanon, and this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
