ORDINANCE NO. 1078

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section (1) That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Lebanon are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Morse Brothers, dba Lebanon Sand & Gravel, for street improvements and to obligate the city for the payment of \$43,115.82 for said street improvements, and that the contracts refer to the plans and specifications heretofore filed by the City Engineer and approved by the Common Council and shall be in the following form, to-wit:

CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION

THIS CONTRACT, made and entered into this 20th day of July, 1960, by and between the CITY OF LEBANON, OREGON, by its Council, hereinafter called the City, and MORSE BROS., dba Lebanon Sand & Gravel, of Lebanon, hereinafter called the Contractors.

W I T N E S S E T H :

Said Contractor, in consideration of the sums to be paid to it by the said City, of the covenants and agreements herein contained, hereby agrees, at its own proper cost and expense, to do all the work and furnish all the materials, except those to be furnished by the City, as listed in the General Conditions, tools, labor and all appliances and appurtenances for the construction of the improvement of streets, to the extent of the proposal made by the Contractor on the 19th day of July, 1960, all in full compliance with the Contract Documents referred to herein.

The Advertisement for Bids, the Information for Bidders, the signed copy of the Proposal made by the Contractor on the 19th day of July, 1960, the General Conditions, Specifications and Plans, which consist of fourteen sheets numbered and titled as follows:

- 1 Catch Basin Details
- 1a Standard Manhole Details
- 2 Typical Section twelve foot Alley
- 3 Typical Section Street, 40 feet between curbs
- 3a Typical Section Street, 33 feet between curbs
- 4 Details of Curbs
- 4a Details of Curbs and Walks
- 5 Plan and Profile Fifth Street, Section 1
- 5a Plan and Profile Fifth Street, Section 2
- 7 Plan and Profile Maple Street
- 8 Plan and Profile Third Street, Section 1
- 8a Plan and Profile Third Street, Section 2

are hereby made a part of this Contract.

In consideration of the faithful performance and the work herein embraced, as set forth in these Contract Documents, and in accordance with the direction of the Engineer and to his satisfaction

to the extent provided in the Contract Documents, the City agrees to pay the Contractor the amounts earned, computed on the unit price basis, as determined by the Contract Documents and based on the said proposal made by the Contractor and to make such payments in the manner and at the times provided in the Contract Documents.

The Contractor agrees to complete the work within the time specified herein and to accept as full payment herein the amounts computed and determined by the Contract Documents and based on the said Proposal.

It is agreed that the time limit for the completion of the Contract based upon the Proposal, shall be the 30th day of September, 1960.
