ORDINANCE NO. 1083

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Council of the City of Lebanon be and they hereby are authorized and directed to purchase from Morse Brothers of Lebanon, Oregon, certain construction materials to be used in the Williams Street bridge, said materials to consist of twenty two 20-foot concrete piling and eleven 56-foot 10-inch concrete T beams. The total purchase price for said materials is not to exceed \$7,230.00.

Section 2. Whereas the Williams Street bridge is in a state of disrepair and now a hazard to vehicular traffic, it is necessary that immediate action be taken to repair and improve said bridge and the materials aforementioned to be purchased from Morse Brothers are necessary for the said improvements; therefore, this Ordinance is declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 20th day of December, 1960.
