THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following described real property, situated within the city limits of Lebanon, Linn County, Oregon, be and hereby is changed from "Zone 1" (residential) to "Zone 2" (residential), to-wit:

Beginning 5 feet west of the Northeast corner of Lot 1, Block 1, Smith's First Addition to the City of Lebanon; thence west along the north line of said Lot 45 feet; thence south parallel with the east line of said lot 126 feet; thence east along the south line of said Lot 45 feet; thence north parallel with the east line of said Lot 126 feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2: There is a development anticipated in the above described property at this time which, in the opinion of the Council, would be advantageous to the City of Lebanon. Now, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be immediately operative and effective from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
