ORDINANCE NO. 1096

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 14 of Ordinance No. 659, paragraph 7 thereof, is amended as follows:

Section 14. In paragraph 7 of said section delete the first sentence thereof which reads as follows: "The petitioners shall also furnish a complete list of names and addresses of owners, together with a description of all property in the affected area.", and insert in lieu thereof the following sentence: "The Petitioners shall pay the City \$10.00 plus the City's actual costs of ascertaining ownership, mailing notices and advertising as required herein."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
