THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Council of the City of Lebanon be and they are authorized and directed to purchase from Ragsdale Motors of Lebanon, Oregon, a 1963 GMC Model V4000 truck chassis equipped with dump box and twin hoist at a cost to the City of \$4,285.79 in cash and the trade-in of the City's 1946 Ford Dump Truck.

Section 2. Whereas said truck is needed immediately for the preservation and maintenance of city property, now, therefore, this Ordinance is declared to be necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
