THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The base salaries of the following city officers and employees, commencing July 1, 1962, and continuing until further Ordinance of the Council, shall be in the amounts set after the office as follows:

Section 2: All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, which are in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3: The Salaries and Compensation of all other City employees shall be the amount approved by the Budget Committee and adopted in the annual budget.

Section 4: The 1962-63 budget which has been adopted calls for the above sums of money to be paid to the respective officers during the fiscal year July 1, 1962, through June 30, 1963, and the various officers and employees of the City of Lebanon above named have relied upon said salaries. Therefore, this Ordinance is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
