ORDINANCE NO. 1113

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Effective July 1, 1962, the compensation of the monthly-salaried, full-time employees of the City of Lebanon is the base pay plus longevity pay as follows:

\$5.00 per month for those who have been employed for not less than 1 year nor more than 3 years;

\$10.00 per month for those who have been employed for not less than 3 years nor more than 5 years;

\$20.00 per month for those who have been employed for not less than 5 years nor more than 10 years;

\$25.00 per month for those who have been employed for not less than 10 years.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
