ORDINANCE NO. 1114

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 519 is amended by the insertion of a
section 7, to read as follows:

"Section 7. POSSESSING, RECEIVING OR CONCEALING STOLEN
PROPERTY. It shall be unlawful for any person to receive, or
possess, or conceal or attempt to conceal any stolen money or
property, knowing or having good reason to believe that it
was stolen."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are
necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety
of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to
exist, and this Ordinance shall ⁱⁿ be full force and effect immediately upon
its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

January, 1963.
