ORDINANCE NO. 1119

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: <u>Section 1</u>. Sections 5 and 6 of Ordinance No. 518 are hereby repealed. <u>Section 2</u>. A new Section 5 of Ordinance No. 518 is hereby enacted and shall read as follows:

"Section (5). Any person being the owner or having the control of any dog, who shall suffer or permit such dog to run at large and commit a nuisance or damage to the person or property of another shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor. Prosecution of said person pursuant to this section shall be instituted only upon the filing of a complaint by the person suffering or sustaining such nuisance or damage.

<u>Section 3</u>. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 518 is renumbered "Section 6". <u>Section 4</u>. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
