ORDINANCE NO. 1121

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Council of the City of Lebanon be and they hereby are authorized and directed to purchase from Morse Brothers of Harrisburg, Oregon, certain construction materials to be used in the Grant Street bridge, said materials to consist of nineteen 35' X 3' X 1'3" slabs, and twenty-two 20' X 13" octagonal piling, and seventy lineal feet of 11' X 2' concrete railing. The total purchase price for said materials is estimated to be \$9,755.00.

Section 2. Whereas the immediate construction and improvement of said bridge is necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor this 7th day of May, 1963.
