ORDINANCE NO. 1123

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Any person who obtains transportation of a taxicab and who, with intent to defraud, after obtaining such transportation removes himself or the personal property from the taxicab without first paying or tendering a reasonable amount as payment for the transportation, shall be fined upon conviction not more than \$25, or imprisoned for not more than 10 days, or both.

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of the Ordinance are necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, welfare and safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
