ORDINANCE NO. 1133

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4. of Ordinance No. 1130 shall be amended  
to read as follows:

"Section 4. Monthly-salaried, full-time employees  
who have been employed more than 3 years, and who  
receive no pay increase in 1963 pursuant to the above  
schedule, are hereby granted a longevity pay increase  
of \$10.00 per month effective July 1, 1963."

Section 2. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are  
necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and  
safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect  
immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

September, 1963.
