ORDINANCE NO. 1140

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LEBANON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 519 is amended as follows:

Section 2. Sections 78, 79, 80 and 81 are renumbered to
read as Sections 100, 101, 102 and 103 respectively.

Section 3. A new Section 78 shall be added to read as follows:

"Section 78. LARCENY.

It shall be unlawful for any person to steal the property
of another, to the value of \$75.00 or less, or to willfully
take, carry, lead or drive away the property of another,
to the value of \$75.00 or less, with the intent to deprive
such other of such property permanently."

Section 4. Sections 79 to 99 inclusive reserved for expansion.

Section 5. Inasmuch as the provisions of this Ordinance are
necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and
safety of the people of the City of Lebanon, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and
effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by
the Mayor.

of February, 1964.
